South Dakota Code of Conduct:

Standards of conduct are part of the ASA National Code and South Dakota rules and regulations. Any manager, coach, player, or other Individual(s) affiliated with any ASA team shall respect these Standards.

No unsportsmanship conduct or any derogatory action on or off the playing field shall be allowed.

No verbal or physical attacks or threats upon an umpire or an ASA official, coach, fan or ASA registered player.

No destruction of property, abusive behavior or violation of state or federal laws.

No non-payment of team-incurred debts.

No playing under an assumed name or falsifying official ASA documents.

No writing checks with non-sufficient funds or account closed checks to an ASA official, umpire, team member, individual or business.

No commission of larceny or fraud perpetrated against an ASA official, team or individual.

No commission of any acts that are contrary to the objectives and purposes of the ASA or the league in which you are associated.

Coaches shall become familiar with the objectives of the youth sport program with which you are affiliated.

Conduct all practices and games so that all athletes have an opportunity to improve their skill level through active participation.

Cooperate with the administration of the organization in the enforcement of rules and regulations, and report any irregularities that violate sound competitive practices.

With my signature, which I voluntarily affix to this pledge, I acknowledge that I have read, understand and will act in accordance with the by-laws set forth by the Brandon Valley Youth Softball Association and the South Dakota Amateur Softball Association.

PENALTIES: Immediate ejection and removal from the premises. The BVYSA Board of Directors will take subsequent action (ie. Game suspensions for coaches, parents, fans and/or teams).
